

Sound Reinforcement for Operators Tours Resurrection Life Church



Resurrection Life Church features a 2-level, fan-shaped worship center that seats up to 4,200 members. The Church offers multi-media services and often hosts national Christian music performances for the community.

Attendees of Syn-Aud-Con's Sound Reinforcement for Operators seminar held recently in Grand Rapids, Michigan were treated to a technical tour of the newly opened worship center at Resurrection Life Church.

Resurrection Life Church, a 4,200-seat facility offering contemporary services in Grandville, Michigan (just outside of Grand Rapids) is served by some of the leading elements of audio technology available.

Featuring a beautiful and highly functional two-level, fan-shaped worship center, Resurrection Life Church also boasts a campus that includes a 26-room nursery/youth ministries facility, chapel, and café. The tour was conducted by Cliff Rosenberg, technical director for the church.



The worship facility systems consists primarily of a Digico D5 Live console at FOH and a D1 Live on stage for monitors; L-Acoustics KUDO line array loudspeakers, Crown I-Tech Series and CT Series power amplifiers, BSS London digital signal processing, an assortment of wired and wireless microphones and numerous Aviom Pro 16 Series personal monitoring stations.

The system was designed by Acoustic Dimensions, of Dallas, Texas and implemented by the Communications Division of Parkway Electric conveniently located in Holland, Michigan.
